Camp Arrival

Cloverbuds must be signed in at day camp between 10:45 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. at the Ramser 4-H Center. There will not be supervision for campers dropped off before 10:45 a.m. They may want to bring a water bottle to use throughout the day- we have a refill station. We will provide a snack in the afternoon.

Camp Dismissal

Cloverbuds must be signed out before leaving when they are dismissed at 3:00 p.m. We understand that there are situations where parents have a right to restrict who will pick up their child at the end of camp. When you sign in your Cloverbud at the beginning of the day you will indicate who will be picking them up.

Who Can Attend?

Youth who are enrolled as Cloverbud for 2021 are eligible to attend. Also they can bring a friend that is still in the same criteria (age 5 and in kindergarten until they reach age 8 and in the third grade).
