***DRUG USE

- Forms will be submitted online.
  - Stations will be available at Livestock Interview Judging to complete, if assistance is needed.
- Must be submitted by Thursday, July 22.
  - If forms are incomplete the exhibitor will be disqualified and not able to exhibit.
  - Our ODA representative will be conducting the DUNF check.



# ***DRUG RESIDUE-FREE ANIMALS***

- All animals required to complete a DUNF must be **drug residue-free** as they come through the vet check station on move-in day of the fair. If you have any questions, please contact Samantha Beheler.
